To whom it may concern:

We are sending you this letter as a reminder that any and all electrical work being done in Greene County must be done by a Greene County licensed electrician. All Greene County electricians must hold a "Class A" License issued by the Greene County Board of Electrical Examiners. Electricians that are licensed in reciprocating areas must obtain a "Class B" Permit also issued by our office. The definition of such licenses are as follows:

CLASS A - To perform the work of Master Electrician. "Master Electrician" shall in short mean any person engaged in the installation or repair of electrical wiring, appliances or devices for heat, light or power purposes or for signaling devices operating on 50 volts or more and any person who supervises or contracts to perform the foregoing work.

CLASS B - To perform the work of Master Electrician but only for a single job or installation at one location or property. Must have current valid license from another area that honors our license.
