Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Halcott:

TOWN OF HALCOTT

Local Law No. 1 of the Year 2003

TITLE

A Local Law to create office of Tax Collector and separate tax collection from the office of Town Clerk.

SECTION 1:

Town Board of the Town of Halcott hereby creates the office of elective tax collector for the purpose of collecting Real Property taxes in the town. After the office of such tax collector is established, Real Property Taxes shall be collected by such officer and not by the town clerk, as provided by law.

SECTION 2:

The term of office of the tax collector established by this local law shall be two years provided however that if this local law is approved at a special election to be held prior to the 2003 biennial election the position is so created, the town board shall appoint a person to the vacant position of tax collector to serve until December 31, 2003. At the 2003 biennial election a tax collector shall be elected for a term of two years, as provided in this local law.

SECTION 3:

Local Law #1-1999 is hereby repealed; and this local law supersedes Section 36 of the Town Law.

SECTION 4:

This local law shall be submitted to a mandatory special election in accordance with Section 23 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

SECTION 5:

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State following the special election as provided in Section 4 of this local law.


